### **05/35 Planning**

#### **a. to consider planning applications received:**

B/05/507 Hartest Primary School, The Row, IP29 4DL Application under Regulation 3 of the Town and Country General Regulations 1992 - Erection of extension to provide computer room (alternative scheme to that approved under cover of application ref: B/03/1234).

Council fully supported the application and had no objection.

B/05/500 Hartest Mill, Mill Lane, IP294JN Change of use of agricultural land to domestic garden

After confirming that no footpath was affected, Council had no objection, but wanted to ensure that any trees or hedges removed to accommodate the change would be suitably replaced.

B/05/483 Tandem House, Hartest Hill, IP294ET Reduction of a row of Cypress trees (by no more than 1/3).  
Tree officer's report had no objection.

B/05/303 Gifford's Meadow, Shimpling Road, Stanstead, IP29 4EY Outline - Erection of building for use as winery  
Following a long discussion it was agreed that the application would not be opposed, but Council had concern over the addition of a building to a green field site, and the size and height of the building which would impact upon the surroundings. Council also wished to remind planners of the weight restriction on the Shimpling Road bridge into Hartest and to ask planners to ensure that additional screening was provided to reduce the impact of the building.

B/05/493 The Old Stores, The Row, IP294DJ Application for listed building Consent - Retention of pitched slate roof and replacement doors to rear. (retrospective for works already carried out)

Council was surprised that the occupant of a listed building had not realised that planning permission was required for any alterations, but thought that the works carried out were an improvement. Council had no objection.
